## **Celebrating Wynn Hospital's One Year Anniversary**

On October 29, 2023, we moved 226 patients to Wynn Hospital from St. Luke's and St. Elizabeth – and all in less than 10 hours.

It's hard to believe that a year has gone by since that first day. We are so grateful to everyone who was a part of that first day, and to those who have been working with us since that day, ensuing we continue to deliver high-quality care to our community.

The opening of the Wynn Hospital is the beginning of a new chapter in healthcare for the Mohawk Valley – and it's so much more than a hospital! A medical campus is forming in downtown Utica. Earlier this year, CNY Cardiology moved their offices to State Street across from the Wynn Hospital ED. MVHS opened a retail pharmacy and a lab blood draw station in the same location, and we're awaiting NYS approval to open imaging and specialty physician offices there as well.

Our footprint in medical education has also been growing dramatically! Over the last two years, we have added five residency programs to our medical education division. Today, we have residents in podiatry, psychiatry, OB/GYN, general surgery and transitional year – in addition to our two long-standing residency programs in family medicine and dentistry. Plus, we are the clinical site for third and fourth year medical students from Lake Erie College of Osteopathic Medicine and the University of New England. That's more than 140 physician learners on our campus today. That's in addition to the nursing students from our St. Elizabeth College of Nursing and other clinical students from area colleges. Yes, we are truly a teaching hospital and medical campus!
