MVHS Volunteer Services

Do you know what a valuable role MVHS volunteers play in supporting our patients, residents, employees and organization?

Volunteers work throughout MVHS – providing pastoral care, delivering mail, assisting in the Employee Store, providing information and directions at the reception desks, keeping families updated in the waiting rooms, rocking babies in the NICU, rounding on patients in the hospital, helping in our rehab facilities, long-term care center and medical offices and providing customer and sales service in the gift shop.

In 2023, MVHS had 62 volunteers who donated more than 26,400 hours of their time and talents to help MVHS patients, residents, families, employees and medical staff. Currently, we have more than 85 volunteers working in more than 20 different areas.

Volunteers are also in charge of running the Gift Shop at Wynn Hospital and the vendor sales throughout the organization. Funds raised from these areas go to the Volunteer Association, which works with the MVHS Foundation to donate back to the hospital to support programs and services. In 2023, the Volunteer Association made a five-year commitment of \$150,000 to the Capital Campaign for the Wynn Hospital. In addition to the Capital Campaign commitment, the Volunteer Association also gifted \$27,500 to MVHS in 2024 to support the Wynn Hospital Gala and Children's Miracle Network Hospitals at MVHS.

The MVHS Volunteer Department oversees all volunteers throughout the organization as well as the Gift Shop and vendor sales. Michele Dovi is the manager for the department and Stephanie Cullop just recently joined our organization as the Volunteer Coordinator.

MVHS has openings for volunteers to assist in several departments. The assignments and work schedules are flexible. Additionally, Volunteer Services is looking to add areas and departments for
